2. **Minutes of the previous meeting:**

3. **Business arising from the minutes:**

- A. **IRC 2025** - Australian Rangeland Society has underwritten \$20,000 to support the 2025 IRC Australian bid.
- B. **IRC 2025 briefing note to NSW DPI** – a copy was not obtained, so the deadline was missed.
- C. **Letter of support for IRC 2025 from DAFQ** – the deadline to send a request for in-principle support for IRC 2025 from DAFQ was missed.
- D. **A special issue of TRJ** - to be based on the Canberra ARS Conference will include papers from early career scientists and the information gleaned from The World Café session.
- E. **Regional NRM Group sponsored landholders at ARS Conferences** – most rangelands-based Regional NRM groups offer sponsorship for land holders to attend conferences. The uptake of these offers has been variable. It was recommended that ARS Council & members make direct approaches to landholders to increase the numbers applying for Regional NRM group sponsorship.
- F. **ARS Conference link** on the front page of the ARS website was updated before the conference.
- G. **Legal matters** with Qld DAF for TRJ Drought Management Special Issue have been resolved.
- H. **Guest editor** for TRJ Drought Management Special Issue will be Jacqui Wilcox (**Andrew to follow-up**)
- I. **Position of PC Chair** – letters were sent to all associate editors. (**Bob to follow-up**)
- J. **An article thanking Ron Hacker** for his dedication and achievements as Chair of the Publications Committee has been sent to the RMN editor.
- K. **Archiving of all ARS files** - Australian Institute of Agricultural Science and Technology use a commercial provider. Current ARS files are to be sent to David Phelps at Longreach by Carol Ireland. David is to liaise with Carol about delivery of same. (**David to action**)
- L. **ARS Travel grants 2020** - an article promoting 2020 travel grants for to members was published in the RMN.
- M. **Letter of support from the ARS for the IYRP** has been sent to the Mongolian Government and Dana Kelly.
- N. **Remaining length of tenure of current ARS board members** – David Phelps' second 4 year term will conclude at the 2021 AGM, Bob Shepherd's at the 2025 AGM, Andrew Ash, Don Burnside, Megan Munchenberg, Dionne Walsh, Cathy Waters & Angus Whyte at the 2023 AGM. But Andrew, Don, Megan, Dionne, Cathy & Angus should have been re-nominated after their first 4 year term, ie in 2019. This was an oversight at the 2019 AGM.

- O. Canberra ARS conference organisers** included membership benefits and a prompt to encourage people to publish in TRJ on the rolling screen saver on the projection screen during the conference. Membership application forms were distributed in the main foyer.
- P. The Publications Committee was advised of the 13 recommendations** pertaining to social media that were approved at the July 2019 ARS Council meeting.
- Q. Next ARS biennial conference – Qld** – Key people were approached in NW Qld, but no interest was shown as key people have are or have left the district. There is however some interest and potential support in Longreach including local tourism operators. A letter is to be written to the Longreach Regional Council under David Phelps signature **(Bob to action)**
- R. Royal Society of Qld “Rangelands Dialogue”** – outcomes from the “Declaration for the Future of Our Rangeland (Qld)” workshop that was held in Brisbane in August 2019, were circulated to ARS Council members by Bob Shepherd & David Phelps (two separate documents). ARS Council is concerned that there is no identifiable pathway for implementation or action. This and the need for the dialogue to be Australia-wide, are viewed as essential to the further development the document. It was resolved that the ARS Council writes a letter of “support in principle” of the dialogue to the RSQ, and that the ARS keep abreast of developments in the document. **(Bob to action)**
(Andrew Ash left the meeting at this point)

5. Business Arising from Correspondence

- 1) **ARS membership of rangelands-based Regional NRM groups.** Membership of all of these groups is free.
Motion: That the ARS apply for membership of all rangelands-based Regional NRM groups in Australia.

- 2) **ARS Travel & Study Grants**
(a) Guidelines need to be rewritten to state that applicants must be ARS members for 12 months prior to the date of making an application for a grant, not 12 months prior to the proposed date of using the grant. **(Don to action)**
(b) Travel grant applications for 2020 – as applications will close on the 30th November 2019, an out of session email meeting will be scheduled for the ARS Council to make the assessments. **(Bob to action)**
- 3) **World Café Session at Canberra ARS Conference** – it is intended that the outcomes of this session will be published in TRJ, most likely in a Special Issue with other conference papers. The Publications Committee will decide on the format and logistics of including the World Café Session in TRJ. The secretary is to send a reply to John Taylor’s email about the World Café Session. **(Bob to action)**
(Andrew Ash returned to the meeting at this point)
- 4) **Australian rangeland futures: time now for systemic responses to interconnected challenges** (*Barney Foran et. al.*) – This paper is in the Port Augusta ARS Conference Special Issue of TRJ (2019, 41, 271–292) and was sent by Barney to eight Federal Government Ministers. Positive feedback was received from two Ministers (Agriculture and Resources & Northern Australia); other ministers are yet to respond. Discussion by ARS Council members included the following points:-
- ARS Council members must fully understand the intent and underlying purpose of the paper
 - Rangelands-based Regional NRM groups need to be involved in, and empowered by the concepts outlined in the paper
 - The paper is very relevant to the development of a range of policies, including a national drought policy which is currently topical
 - Barney is an excellent advocate at all levels for the rangelands
 - Council is keen to work with Barney to advance the proposals in the paper **(David to action)**
- It was resolved that:-
- a) Barney Foran be asked to more fully articulate the intent of the paper and how and where Council can support its implementation. **(Bob & Don to Action)**

- b) Council to make Barney Foran (CSU) and Dr Geoff Edwards (Royal Society of Qld) and their respective rangelands papers/ rangelands dialogue, known to each other as a means of furthering the development of a nation-wide rangelands document. **(Bob to action)**

6. Reports

6.1 Membership Report (Don Burnside, Membership Director)

Membership Update – 27 November 2019

The summary

At the commencement of 2019, there were 209 active and complimentary members. As at 18 November 2019, we have 221.

The detail

As at 16 November 2019, 132 members have paid for annual memberships for 2019, with 14 people who have taken up three year memberships (2019-2021). When added to the members already on three year memberships (31 three year memberships taken up in 2017 and 2018), a total of 177 members – so far – are financial and hence ‘active’ for 2019.

A further 9 new members who have joined since 1 October, are active until the end of 2020. Some of these attended the Canberra conference.

In mid-October, 14 members (both paid for 2018, and complimentary) were advised that their memberships were terminated and that they have been moved into the inactive category. This is about the usual number we lose every year. It is disappointing that the people who receive complimentary memberships as prizes do not choose to move to paid membership at the end of their ‘complimentary year’.

Because we have members now paid up until 31 December 2021, we have taken in additional membership fees – to the value of \$4,468 (excl of GST).

Overall therefore, we have 186 paid members at this time, which compares favourably with 163 for the whole of 2018.

Notes on financial Report for 1 January to 31 October 2019

Membership income – Membership income was higher in 2019 than in previous years, even after accounting for 34 people who have paid for 2020 and 2021. (Note – balance sheet includes \$4,468 retained for payments made for 2020 and 2021 memberships)

Journal income – Payment has been received for two special issues so far this year. The NSW DPI has paid for the Total Grazing Pressure SI which will be published in early 2020, and \$10,000 was transferred from the Conference Account as payment for the ARS2019 Conference Special Issue. Mark Stafford Smith is seeking support from ACIAR to cover that cost, which will in effect increase conference income. There is no date available yet for the publication of this SI.

Journal expenses – a payment of \$1,800 was made to CSIRO Publishing for excess pages (18) in Volume 40 of the Journal (our contract is limited to 600 pages). Payment of 50 per cent (\$9,091) of the annual publishing fee for the Journal has been made to CSIRO Publishing. It is not certain when CSIRO Publishing will invoice for the second payment. Prize money of \$1,000 provided for winners at ARS2019 has been disbursed (\$300 retained by people who donated their prize money back to the Society). Copyright and royalties income was higher than expected.

Website and Social media – 50 per cent of the full fee has been paid to Blue Platypus for set-up of the new website. Set-up is proceeding well as discussed in the PC Report. Other costs include back payment to Russell Grant for his editorship of the website in 2018, plus honoraria to Sarah Moles for editing Social media (commenced 3 December 2018) and final payment to Wright Social for looking after the social media sites before appointment of the SME. A final payment of \$5,950 will need to be made to Blue Platypus once the website reconstruction is complete.

Honoraria – payment of \$2,500 has been made to Ron Hacker, outgoing Chair of the Publications Committee for serves over the year ending 30 June 2019. Payment of \$2,750 paid to Don Heylen for Bookkeeping for 2019.

Conference profit – the ARS2019 Canberra conference looks set to yield a profit of about \$30,000, which is better than was budgeted (\$20,000). Note that the costs include the transfer of \$10,000 as payment for the Special Issue of TRJ that will derived from conference proceedings. My understanding is that one reason for the higher than expected profit is that thanks to George Wilson's Adjunct Professorial position at ANU, there was no charge for the Kambri Venue.

Travel support – Council agreed to support Dana Kelly's travel to Kenya in relation to IRC Continuing Committee matters and she provided an invoice for \$2,000 in July 2019. However, payment has not been made as a report on Dana's travel to Kenya has not been provided.

GST transactions Qs 1 to 3 - To obtain a true picture of the conference finances, an attempt is being made to separate the GST credits and liabilities between normal operations and conference operation.

GST payable on normal operations has \$334 so far this year. Given that nearly all of the income was received in Qs1-3 2019, but that some expenses were paid in late 2018 and there have been some paid since 1 November, the GST calculated to be paid of \$8,203 is high. We can expect to recover some GST when the Q4 BAS is completed in early 2020.

a. The Rangeland Journal

The number of papers submitted to the journal to date (73) is well down on 2018 but comparable to 2017. It will not be possible to publish all six issues of volume 41 in calendar 2019. Volume 5 will be published in December, probably with 7 or 8 papers. The Special Issue (SI) on total grazing pressure management in the southern rangelands, which will form issue 6 of volume 41, will not be ready for publication before late February 2020. Such late publication is not uncommon, and it will not affect the target of six issues in 2020 for volume 42.

Other special issues currently in train are *Drought Management and Policy* (contract signed with QDPI), *Theory and application of the grassland Comprehensive and Sequential Classification System* (draft contract with Gansu Agricultural University, China, available for President's approval), and the SI to be produced from the 2019 Biennial Conference. However this still leaves a deficit of one SI over the next two years. A SI on the Wambiana grazing trial has been suggested, and I have made contact with Peter O'Reagain in that regard, but it is not clear if this SI will eventuate.

A suggestion to fill the potential gap in the publication schedule is to publish Abstracts from the Biennial conference (apart from those which will contribute to the conference SI) as a stand-alone issue. However, this may be a risky strategy if organisations like Web of Science counted each as a separate publication for the purposes of calculating the impact Factor. It also seems likely that additional cost may also be involved. For the moment we have opted to go with late publication of Issue 6 for volume 41 but Council could usefully consider its attitude towards such a move if the need arose in the future.

The PC is developing a working group to more actively solicit SI's. Part of this development will be the production of a brochure to promote to prospective sponsors the benefits of publishing a SI in TRJ. CSIRO Publishing has provided some excellent material that can be used in such a brochure which I hope will be available in draft form before the end of the year.

CSIRO Publishing has produced a new flyer for TRJ which has been distributed to Advisory Editors and Council. Feedback from several of the Advisory Editors has been very positive. It is expected that Advisory Editors, members of Council and the PC will take whatever opportunities arise to use this flyer to promote the journal.

A new format for the publisher's annual report for the journal has been proposed by CP. This will be in line with developments in other journals and will provide considerably more detailed information. This was agreed to at the Canberra meeting and I have confirmed with CP that they should proceed to use the new format.

Three of the journals Advisory Editors recently undertook a project to read two recently published papers each and identify any production issues that detract from the quality of the published product (e.g. spelling and punctuation errors, English expression etc.). The analysis revealed many such issues, albeit often minor, even in generally well written papers, and a continuing problem with English expression in papers by authors of non-English speaking background. It is difficult to know how best to address the latter. It may be necessary in some cases to require authors to use English language editing services. More use may also need to be made of the small group of voluntary English language editors that is now available to the Editor-in-Chief.

A new Virtual Issue is planned for early 2020 to commemorate the 30th anniversary (in 2019) of the publication of the seminal paper (Westoby *et al.*) which introduced the 'State and Transition' concept. A guide for the preparation of proposals for virtual issues has been provided by CP.

b. Range Management Newsletter

The third issue for 2019 is in preparation. In implementing the Council's strategic direction for development of RMN Noelene Duckett has contacted 53 other newsletters/ magazines operating in a similar domain to ARS, with a view to collaboration or sharing of material. Six organisations have indicated that they are keen to collaborate in sharing material and a further three have indicated that RMN can use their material with appropriate permission/acknowledgement.

c. Web site

The second round of testing of the new site is underway, coordinated by Russell Grant. A number of issues remain to be resolved, in particular access to the Members Area and operation of the link to TRJ from

within that area (which provides members with free access to the journal archive). It is expected that the new site will 'go live' by the end of November. It will look identical to the current site although some aspects of functionality will differ with the new platform (e.g. membership renewal, newsletter uploading). We have been advised that server space for the current web site has been paid only until 1 January 2020. The current site will disappear on this date if new server space is not paid for beforehand. It is therefore essential that the new site be operational before that date.

d. Social media

Sarah Moles provided the attached report (Attachment 1) which indicates that the society's presence in social media is steadily increasing. At its July 2019 meeting Council accepted the 13 recommendations of the review of social media usage by the society. These recommendations have been provided to the SME and she will now commence to implement them in discussion with the PC. Since Sarah was not part of the review she may have some alternative views on some matters which will need to be taken into account in implementing the recommendations.

e. General

a. Acknowledgement of CSIRO Publishing as a sponsor of the Biennial conference

Our Journal Publisher, Dr Marisa Spiniello, has requested that CP be recognised as a sponsor of the biennial conference as they provide prizes for winning presenters, and staff a promotional booth for the journal. They would like to have their logo included with the logos of other sponsors. I indicated that I would put this request to Council so that a direction to this effect could be given to the next Organising Committee if Council agrees. I would like to be able to advise CP of Council's decision as soon as possible.

b. Letters of acknowledgement

A number of changes have recently occurred within the PC and the voluntary editorial staff of TRJ that require acknowledgement from the President or Secretary

- i. Adjunct Assoc. Prof Wal Whalley will retire from the PC, and from his appointment as an Associate Editor, on 31 December 2019. He may be willing to accept an appointment as an Advisory Editor and I have approached him in that regard. I intend to prepare an article for RMN to mark Wal's retirement.
- ii. Dr David Eldridge will retire from the Publications Committee as of 31 December 2019. David was appointed to the PC in 2009.
- iii. Dr Digby Race has accepted an extension of his appointment as an Associate Editor until 31 December 2022.
- iv. Professor Osvaldo Sala resigned from his position as Advisory Editor on 16 November 2019. He was appointed as an Advisory Editor in October 2012.

Report from Sarah Moles, Social Media Editor, 13 November 2019

I've learned a bit about how the Facebook and Twitter analytics work and will change the times at which I schedule posts accordingly. 400 or more of our Facebook followers tend to be online between midnight and 3 am; and 5 pm and midnight (Pacific Time).

Our Twitter audience is estimated to be 65% women. An estimated 75% of our audience like dogs and science news, 95% like weather and 93% like astronomy.

Since my last report I feel there has been a better mix of links to TRJ articles/abstracts and info, regional news posts and other posts aimed at getting people to click through to our website. Discounts on CSIRO products are well received on Twitter.

Having a photo to accompany a post referring to TRJ abstracts made a very noticeable difference. I do hope more will be forthcoming!

Twitter analytics are summarised for 28 day period.

- Followers up 20 on previous 28 day period

- October tweets = 21,400 impressions
- Top October tweet, Fiona Simpson interviewed by Katharine Murphy = 5670 impressions
- So far, top November tweet is about Astro tourism in the rangelands = 430 and total Nov impressions = 10,400
- Total impressions for previous 28 days = 23,300, an increase of 53% over previous 28 days period.

Facebook analytics for past 28 days.

- Post featuring Bob's photo of ARS prizewinners top scored with reach of 492, 124 post clicks and 119 reactions. (Thanks for sharing that picture, Bob!)
- Post re Guardian article about the link between land clearing and climate change =219 reach and 31 engagements
- Post 11/11/19 re ABC radio piece on growing numbers of women rangers working on country – 91 reach 11 engagements in 24 hours.
- Total post reach 14 Oct – 10 Nov = 947
- A reach of between 100 & 200 seems to be our 'normal' range.

- a) **ARS Website** – Payment of invoice to Blue Platypus before the website is live was discussed. Feedback is to be sent to Russell Grant to proceed with going live before 6th December 2019. **(David to action)**
- b) **Voluntary editorial staff of TRJ** – Letters to be written acknowledging the contribution of the voluntary editorial staff of TRJ that have either retired or extended their tenure. **(Bob & David to action)**
- c) **CSIRO sponsorship of the Canberra ARS Conference** – ARS Council authorized Ron Hacker to advise CSIRO that their logo will be included with the other conference sponsors **(Bob to action)**
- d) **Wambiana Special Issue of TRJ** – Secretary to speak with Dr Peter O'Reagain **(Bob to action)**
- e) **Articles for RMN** – Permission has been obtained from Ian McLean "Bush AgriBusiness" to use an article from their website with the appropriate attribution. **(Bob to action)**
- f) **Organisations agreeing to share articles with the RMN** – Noelene Duckett contacted organisations on the list that was provided earlier this year, with nine agreeing to share articles. The list is to be circulated to Council members. **(Don to action)** Megan to ascertain if Southern Gulf NRM responded to this request **(Megan to action)**

7. General/New Business:

1. **ARS bid for IRC 2025** – ARS Council was very impressed with the content and quality of the bid to host the 2025 IRC in Australia. A letter of appreciation is to be sent to Pieter Conradie and the bid committee for their efforts. A copy of the bid is to be sent to the ARS Council members. **(Bob to action)**

2. **IRC Continuing Committee** – two bids have been received to host the 2025 IRC; the Mongolian Society of Range Management and the Australian Rangeland Society. The successful bid will be announced at IRC/IGC in Kenya in October 2020. As David Phelps is a member of the IRC Continuing Committee, he declared a conflict of interest and will not be participating in decision making. The successful society will require one month's notice (in confidence) to prepare promotional material for presentation at the Nairobi IRC.
3. **Drought Future Fund** – <https://www.agriculture.gov.au/ag-farm-food/drought/future-drought-fund> Council discussed this Federal Government initiative at length. The main points were:-
 - Concern about the level of science in the development of this policy
 - The need to avoid re-inventing the wheel
 - ARS missed the opportunity to provide feedback during the development of the fund.
 - It may still be possible to provide ideas to guide policy development and the development of projects
4. **7th National NRM Knowledge Conference** – This biennial conference was held in Wodonga, from 17th to 20th November 2019 with the theme “Creating Resilience through Natural Resource Management – how do we do it?” Megan Munchenberg attended as Chair of Southern Gulf NRM. Funding for rangelands NRM regions to adapt to climate change was a high priority. Outcomes from the conference will make interesting reading for the RMN and Twitter.
