F. Royal Society of Qld “Rangelands Dialogue”

- A letter of in-principle support for the Rangelands Dialogue was sent to Dr Geoff Edwards, Vice-President of the Royal Society of Qld (RSQ) with a CC to Barney Foran. The letter also suggested that Geoff and Barney communicate with each other to further develop the Dialogue and possibly widen its scope to include the whole of Australia’s rangelands.
- The Rangelands Dialogue was intended to represent the views of AgForce, NRM Regions Queensland (formerly the Regional Groups Collective) and the RSQ, but it is now the RSQ only.
- Some concern was expressed that the Dialogue was too high a level to provide a way forward for the rangelands.

I. World Café Session at Canberra ARS Conference – Dr John Taylor is liaising with the Publications Chair Dr Ron Hacker to have this session included in the Canberra Conference Special Issue of TRJ.

J. Australian rangeland futures: time now for systemic responses to interconnected challenges (Barney Foran et. al.) – Barney emailed a framework for a “Systemic Investment and Action Plan” under the following headings:-

1. Investment priorities under the \$10/50/100 million funding options
2. Demographic realities and possible future trends
3. Indigenous populations, location and extent of Indigenous owned land
4. Makeup of Gross Regional Product
5. Critical infrastructure needs
6. Disruption futures
7. Land use pattern, industries, activities, and problems
8. Invasive plants and organisms
9. Doing old things better
10. New activities for jobs, economy and regional resilience

Points of discussion on this framework and the additional suggestions in Barney’s email, were:-

- The framework will contribute to a pathway forward.
- A pithy policy statement is needed to introduce the framework.
- Barney Foran be asked to submit the framework for inclusion in the March edition of the Range Management Newsletter to enlist support from the Society’s membership to further develop the framework. **(Bob to action)**
- It was recommended that the Central Western Qld Region (Longreach region) be considered as a potential pilot area to road-test the framework when it is further developed. This would include working with the regional NRM group Desert Channels Qld (DCQ), Remote Area Planning & Development (RAPAD) Longreach and other organisations/agencies.
- That ARS Council member Megan Munchenberg raise the framework at the next meeting of the “NRM Regions Qld” where the Qld Minister for State Development and Minister for Natural Resources and Mines Dr Anthony Lynham will be in attendance. Megan offered to report back to the next ARS Council meeting. **(Megan to action)**

- After the “NRM Regions Qld” meeting, Megan offered to hold discussions with Andrew Drysdale of the Rangelands NRM Alliance. **(Megan to action)**

Council recognises the potential links between the framework and the Royal Society of Qld’s “Rangeland Dialogue” (see Action Item F above)

- K. ARS Bookkeeper** – Council has approved “Integrity Taxation” in Perth for a three month trial period. A three month agreement between the ARS and Integrity Taxation is to be developed by Council for signature by both parties. An annual fee of ~\$2,100+GST per year is anticipated based on estimated hours. If Integrity Taxation’s performance is satisfactory to the Finance and Audit Officer, they will be offered the position until 31 January 2022. The Finance Director is to notify “Integrity Taxation” accordingly. **(Don to action)**
- L. IBD for ARS Funds** - \$100,000 was transferred from the current on-line saver account (BSB 062619 A/c 10088721) for 8 months at an interest rate of 1.5% pa, with principal and interest paid on maturity in July 2020.
- M. Letter of appreciation to Mark StaffordSmith for Canberra ARS Biennial Conference**
An official letter of appreciation and congratulations has been drafted, but the complete list of Conference Organising Committee members is still to be ascertained from Cathy Waters **(David to action)**
Letters of appreciation are to be written to the conference sponsors. George Wilson has been asked to provide a list with contact details. **(Bob to action)**
- N. ARS Website** – The invoice from Blue Platypus was paid, but there are still some issues with the president@austrangesoc.com.au email account. Council will request ARS Website Editor Russell Grant to include a link to the “Opportunities to apply for research grants and travel fellowships” in the Membership Benefits area. Currently the link is only in the Awards area. Renewing membership where the member’s email address has changed is an issue. All other links are working to date. **(Bob to action)**
- O. Voluntary editorial staff of TRJ** – Letters were written acknowledging the contribution of the voluntary editorial staff of TRJ that have either retired or extended their tenure.
- P. CSIRO sponsorship of the Canberra ARS Conference** – Future conference organising committees are to include CSIRO (and their logo) with the other conference sponsors in recognition of the provision of student prizes. **(Bob to action)**
- Q. Wambiana Special Issue of TRJ** – Dr Peter O’Reagain declined the invitation to produce a Special Issue of TRJ in 2020, due to heavy work commitments.
- R. Articles for the RMN** – permission has been given by Ian McLean “Bush AgriBusiness” to use an article from their website in the RMN with the appropriate attribution. The article has been submitted to the RMN editor Noelene Duckett.
- S. Organisations agreeing to share articles with the RMN** – The list from Noelene Duckett was circulated to Council members. Megan Munchenberg to ascertain if Southern Gulf NRM responded to the request to allow their newsletter articles to be published in the RMN. Megan is to send a list of Rangelands NRM Alliance members to the secretary. **(Megan to action)**

6. Reports

6.1 Membership Report (Don Burnside, Membership Director)

Membership Update – 31 January 2020

The summary

At the commencement of 2019, there were 209 active and complimentary members. As at 31 January 2020, we have 224, including 36 complimentary members.

The detail – 2019

As at 31 December 2019, 131 members had paid for annual memberships for 2019, with 46 members on three year memberships, being a total of 177. An additional 11 people joined in late 2019, and these have been awarded membership for 2020. Thus at the end of 2019, there were 188 financial and members.

Looking forward into 2020

Three 2019 members have already renewed for 2020, there are the 11 new members mentioned above, and there are 25 members on three year memberships (2018-2020 and 2019-2021), making a total of 39 financial members so far this year.

A further 149 members will need to renew for 2020 (or 2020-2022 if they elect for the three year membership), and will be sent renewal notices when the website is ready to handle these.

I also have the list of all non-members who attended the Canberra conference and will endeavour to recruit them, reminding them of what a great conference they recently attended and how we can only continue to provide such events if we have a strong membership.

Because we have members now paid up until 31 December 2021, we have taken in additional membership fees – to the value of \$4,514 (excl of GST).

Notes on financial Report for 1 January 2019 to 31 January 2020

Note: – the figures in the above tables have not been checked by the auditor.

Membership income – Membership income was higher in 2019 than in previous years, even after accounting for 34 people who have paid for 2020 and 2021 (Note – balance sheet includes \$4,514 retained for payments made for 2020 and 2021 memberships). However, the income does include a number of memberships paid for 2020 that were received late in the year.

Renewal notices need to be sent to the 150 members who need to renew this year.

Journal income – Payment has been received for two special issues so far this year. The NSW DPI has paid for the Total Grazing Pressure SI which will be published in early 2020, and \$10,000 was transferred from the Conference Account as payment for the ARS2019 Conference Special Issue.

Mark Stafford Smith is seeking support from ACIAR to enable the whole issue to be Open Access and will be providing a formal proposal to the PC.

Journal expenses – a payment of \$1,800 was made to CSIRO Publishing for excess pages (18) in Volume 40 of the Journal. (Our contract is limited to 600 pages). Payment of 50 per cent (\$9,091) of the annual publishing fee for the Journal has been made to CSIRO Publishing. It is not certain when CSIRO Publishing will invoice for the second payment. Prize money of \$1,000 provided for winners at ARS2019 has been disbursed (\$300 retained thanks to winners who donated their prize money back to the Society). Copyright and royalties income was higher than expected.

Website and Social media – The full fee has been paid to Blue Platypus for set-up of the new website, plus some miscellaneous extras (\$15,591). Other costs include back payment to Russell Grant for his editorship of the website in 2018 and full payment in 2019, plus honoraria to Sarah Moles for editing Social media (commenced 3 December 2018) and final payment to Wright Social for looking after the social media sites before appointment of the SME.

Honoraria – payment of \$2,500 has been made to Ron Hacker, outgoing Chair of the Publications Committee for services over the year ending 30 June 2019. Payment of \$2,750 paid to Don Heylen for Bookkeeping for 2019.

Conference profit – the ARS2019 Canberra conference looks set to yield a profit of about \$38,000 (excl GST), which is better than was budgeted (\$20,000m incl. GST). The conference books are almost closed – some very small items still to be dealt with.

Travel support – Council agreed to support Dana Kelly's travel to Kenya in relation to IRC Continuing Committee matters and she provided an invoice for \$2,000 in July 2019. However, she did not request payment until a report on her travel to Kenya was provided.

Assuming that Douglas Lawton takes up his Travel Grant, he will receive payment of \$2,000.

GST transactions Qs 1 to 3 - To obtain a true picture of the conference finances, an attempt is being made to separate the GST credits and liabilities between normal operations and conference operation. GST payable on normal operations has \$334 so far this year. Given that nearly all of the income was received in Qs1-3 2019, but that some expenses were paid in late 2018 and there have been some paid since 1 November, the GST calculated to be paid of \$8,203 is high. We recovered \$2,980 when the Q4 BAS was submitted in January 2020.

Discussion from Finance Report:-

The cost of the website upgrade was queried. The total cost for website services in 2019 was \$16,271 (ex GST) which consists of:-

- Blue Platypus \$12,354 (\$200 to secure content from old website & \$12,154 agreed figure for the new website)
- Honoraria to Website Editor of \$1,370 for 2018 and \$2,500 for 2019
- Incidentals \$47 (reimbursement to Russell Grant)

The budgeted figure was \$12,154 (ex GST) to Blue Platypus

6.3 Publications Committee Report (Ron Hacker, Chair, Publications Committee)

The Publications Committee (PC) met on 29 January. The following matters are forwarded for Council's information and consideration.

a. The Rangeland Journal

Issue 5 of the 2019 volume was recently received in hard copy but was available on-line at close to the appropriate time. Although this volume contained only seven papers it ran to 85 pages. The Special Issue (SI) on total grazing pressure in the southern rangelands, to be labelled as issue 6 of volume 41, has not yet been finalised. I hope that all papers for this special issue will be accepted by the end of February. This issue will probably run to over 100 pages but the total output for volume 41 should not exceed 600 pages and so should not incur excess page charges for ARS. So far only two papers have been accepted for Vol. 42 Issue 1.

A virtual issue (VI) commemorating the 30th anniversary of the publication of Westoby et al. (1989) has been prepared, mainly by Andrew Ash. Brian Walker and Mark Westoby have prepared an introductory

paper for this VI. As it is longer than the usual introduction CSIRO Publishing has suggested that it be published in TRJ with a link to it in the VI. This may determine the date when the VI goes on-line. Planning is now needed for another VI in 2020.

The two SIs intended for Vol. 42 are 'Resilient future rangelands: integrating environment and livelihoods' (from the Canberra conference) and 'Managing Drought in 2020 and Beyond', which will mostly comprise papers from Queensland DPI. A contract has been forwarded to representatives of the Chinese university consortium wishing to publish the SI 'Theory and application of the grassland Comprehensive and Sequential Classification System' in 2021. The signed contract has not yet been returned as the original recipient apparently did not receive the email forwarded in late December. There is no contract in the pipeline at this time for a second SI in 2021. The hoped-for issue on the Wambiana grazing trial will not now go ahead.

The PC has accepted a suggestion from CSIRO Publishing (CP) that reviewers be given free access to the TRJ archive for the remainder of the calendar year in which they complete their review. This has no financial implications for ARS and may encourage some citations. This practice is operating with a number of other CSIRO journals.

CSIRO Publishing has advised that a rolling strategy plan for TRJ will be provided in February for comment. This may require input from Council as well as PC.

b. Range Management Newsletter

No report available as Noelene Duckett was an apology for the meeting. However, the only issue of concern at the moment is Noelene's ability to load the newsletter onto the new web site (see below).

c. Web site

The new web site is now live, and appears to be indistinguishable from the old, but there are some ongoing teething issues. Some members have been unable to access the Members Area as old passwords are no longer effective. However, members of PC have been able to update their passwords (or reuse their old one) by following the prompts from the 'Forgotten password?' tab at the upper left of the home page, or by trying to log in as usual and following the 'forgotten password' prompts from that point. The link to the TRJ archive within the Members Area is functional.

General advice needs to be given to the members as soon as possible, via social media and the web site home page, regarding the need to renew their passwords. Blue Platypus (BP) is preparing an instructional video for web site administrators (particularly the web site, newsletter and social media editors) but this has not been provided at the time of writing. A matter of some urgency is the notification of members via general email of the need to renew memberships for 2020. Don Burnside has had extensive discussions with BP on this functionality throughout the build but the general email distribution has not yet occurred. Russell Grant will be following up with BP on these matters. The reconstruction of the web site has proved to be a much larger task than I had expected and I wish to record my thanks to Russell for his perseverance in bringing the new site thus far.

d. Social media

Our social media activity achieved a milestone at the end of January with 1053 followers on Facebook. This is the first time our followers have exceeded 1000. Congratulations to Sarah Moles in particular for this achievement. Sentiment on Facebook is overwhelmingly positive, mostly 'Likes' and 'Loves' but posts of a couple of articles with suggestions for drought proofing the Pilbara did stimulate some adverse reaction (to the content of the articles, not the ARS per se). Sarah is always keen to be provided with articles and pictures for Facebook and pictures for Instagram. The task of sourcing material for regular posts is considerable. There is a problem with Instagram at the moment as only five of our posts are showing and our page shows we have no followers, aren't following anyone and have made zero posts. Sarah has not been able to resolve this issue to date she has been advised by Instagram support that free accounts don't have access to email support.

e. General

The PC discussed plans for promoting TRJ at the IGC/IRC in Nairobi in October. Marisa Spiniello has indicated that CP will be incorporating this into their promotional pipeline for 2020-21 activities. Promotional materials that could be provided by CP include journal flyers, journal copies, and a table top pull-up poster. However, she is concerned about transport of these materials to Kenya as previous experience of posting such items has not been good, and has asked if delegates from ARS could assist with the transport. (Both

Don Burnside and I will be participating in a 9 day pre-conference tour starting in Tanzania and will not be available to assist with this task). Points raised in the PC's discussion were:

- There is currently \$1,000 available from 2019-20 promotional funds for TRJ provided by CP; PC agreed that these funds could be used to support the promotion (some other funds from the 2020-21 budget could possibly also be used if necessary);
- Promotional flyers for TRJ could be printed in Nairobi (not by the conference Secretariat) to avoid the transport issue (Subsequent enquiries of Dana Kelly have indicated that this should be possible);
- Council should be encouraged to link promotion of ARS and TRJ to utilise the funds available from CP most effectively.

- The Rangeland Journal*** – an introduction to the next virtual Issue is to be written by Brian Walker and Mark Westoby and will be published in a normal issue with a link to the virtual issue.
- ARS Website*** – The difficulty of renewing memberships when members' email addresses have changed has been raised with Blue Platypus by the Society's Website Editor Russell Grant. (**Bob to follow-up**). It has been difficult to contact Blue Platypus at times.
- Range Management Newsletter*** – Guidelines to upload the RMN to the website are to be provided to the editor Noelene Duckett (**Bob to action**)
- Commissioning a "Southern Rangelands Management" paper -**

Motion: That Council commission a paper provisionally titled 'Principles and guidelines for managing grazing in the southern rangelands of Australia', with Drs Hacker and Holm as leading authors. The leading authors are to be paid \$1,500 each, and the Council will also pay \$1,500 to CSIRO Publishing for the paper to be published Open Access.
