3. **Business arising from the minutes:**

A. 2025 IRC bid

- Dana Kelly's information needs to be redrafted before it goes onto social media - now that an IRC Australia Bid Committee is in place, the need for information for a bid committee is no longer required on social media.
- Pieter Conradie has agreed to lead the development of a 2025 IRC Australia bid. Pieter will organize a bid committee meeting including David Phelps, Don Burnside, Dionne Walsh, Cathy Waters, Andrew Ash, John Gavin, Kate Forest, Nicole Spiegel & Gus Whyte. Bob Shepherd offered support should the 2025 IRC bid be successful. Dana Kelly will be asked to be a member of the bid committee subject to any potential conflict of interest in her present role of chair of the IRC Continuing Committee. (**David to action**)
- Secretary to review past emails to see if any other people indicated an interest in being on an IRC 2025 Bid Committee (**Bob to action**)

B. ARS Award of Excellence

- Proposal is on the agenda for the 2019 AGM 22nd May 2019. Secretary is to send details on the proposed award with the AGM meeting notice to the Range Management Newsletter Editor Noelene Duckett (**Bob to action**)

C. ARS Conference Canberra 2019

- Breakeven registration numbers for the Canberra ARS Conference are 270
- Student registration is \$450 for non-wage earning students. There is also a "Supporter" registration which may provide registration assistance for students.
- Update on the Conference Program Committee activities as provided by Cathy Waters:-
 - Subcommittees have been formed to address challenges and better communicate discussions, correspondence and actions to ARS Council and others.
 - Agriculture & Water Minister Hon. David Littleproud has been asked for sponsorship to support primary producer (grazier/pastoralist) attendance at the conference (still awaiting an outcome from this request)
 - Hon. David Littleproud will also play a role at the conference if it coincides with a parliamentary sitting week and other commitments allow.
 - Western Local Land Services (NSW) have been approached to sponsor attendance by six landholders and a contribution to the cost of a western pre-conference tour.
 - Southern Gulf NRM (Qld) is sponsoring one person to attend.
 - Irene Sobotta MLA has indicated they will sponsor one NABRC grazier member.
 - A list of quality keynote speakers/presenters is in the process of being organised.

- It was suggested that a review paper from a student or early career scientist be added to the program and included in a subsequent special issue of *The Rangeland Journal*. The Conference Organising Committee is to liaise with the Publications Committee **(Cathy to action)**
- A Drought Management session was suggested to outline the approaches that are adopted by a range of jurisdictions in Australia **(Cathy to action)**
- Rangelands NRM (WA) will be approached for landholder sponsorship at the conference **(Don to action)**

D. Underfunding of rangeland-based NRM groups

E. Secretary's ARS email A/C

- Details of alternative email addresses for the secretary & president have been posted on social media. The development of a new website is being arranged which will re-instate the generic ARS email accounts for the president and secretary.

F. Social Media Editor - Heidi Wright has been remunerated for an extra month.

G. Circulate report - "Broadening gap between agriculture & youth" – the web-link was forwarded to ARS Council members. Andrew Ash read an extract from a Qld Agricultural Journal article from the early 1900s that expressed the same sentiment.

H. TRJ Special Issue - Drought management -

- Funds may be available from the Drought & Climate Adaptation Program (DCAP) for a special edition. Follow-up discussion is required with Jacqui Wilcox (CSIRO) and Neil Cliffe **(Andrew & Bob to action)**
- Scott Wallace and Pip Job to be contacted for possible funding from NSW and the outcome relayed to Andrew Ash and the Publications Committee **(Cathy Waters to action)**

I. PC Chair's position:

- ARS Council is responsible for recruiting a Publications Committee chair. The secretary to send a copy of the guidelines for recruiting a new PC Chair to David Phelps, and send a personalized email to all Australia-based associate editors of *The Rangeland Journal* **(Bob to action)**.
- A request for a new chair to go into the next edition of the Range Management Newsletter **(Bob to action)**
- Ron Hacker has kindly agreed to mentor a new PC chairperson and will stay in the role until the position has been filled. Indicative end date for Ron's chairmanship is 30th June 2019.

J. ARS Website:

- Date at the bottom of the first page in Russell Grant's report was corrected.
- Correspondence with Blue Platypus has been circulated to ARS council members.
- Blue Platypus's quote is based on a mainstream web publishing tool "Word Press".
- A contract has been signed with website designer "Blue Platypus" and \$6604 payment (50% of the set-up cost) made by Treasurer Don Burnside.

K. Archive for ARS documents and data

- Andrew Ash spoke with a CSIRO archivist, who indicated that CSIRO could not provide an archive service for the ARS.
- Qld Archives will only accept material of an historical significance. The process of preparing material for archiving is formidable.
- Commercial archive options are expensive.
- The options used by kindred organisations eg Ag Institute of Australia, will be investigated **(Andrew & Don to action)**

L. Travel Grants

- The Social Media Editor has included the alternative email addresses for the president & secretary with a request that anyone who has submitted a travel grant request, to re-send to these email accounts
- A group email was sent from the secretary's email account to members with the above information, but only a proportion were transmitted successfully; the group email will be re-sent from the secretary's DAF email account. **(Bob to action)**.
- An out-of-session decision by the ARS Council:-
That the ARS Council approves funding of \$2000 for Danna Kelly to undertake business on Council's behalf by attending the March 2019 United Nations Environment Assembly 4th

session (UNEA-4) in Nairobi to raise awareness of the call for the International Year of Rangelands and Pastoralists and to ascertain interest/support for Australia to submit a bid for the IRC in 2025. Dana is to furnish a report with findings and recommendations to ARS Council within a month of returning to Australia.

Membership Update – 31 March 2019

The summary

At the commencement of 2019, there were 209 active and complimentary members. As at the end of March 2019, 103 members have renewed their memberships for 2019, including 9 people who have taken up three year memberships (2019-2021). When added to the members already on three year memberships (taken up in 2017 and 2018), a total of 135 members so far, are financial and hence 'active' for 2019.

There are still 43 members who need to renew to maintain their 'active' status, and they are being sent monthly reminders.

So far this year, we have three new members in the Society, but sadly we are farewelling three longstanding members who have asked to be removed from the 'active' list'.

6.3 Publications Committee Report (Ron Hacker, Chair, Publications Committee)

The Publications Committee (PC) met on 27 March 2019. The following matters are forwarded for Council's information and consideration.

a. The Rangeland Journal

Issue 1 of volume 41 was published on schedule at the end of February 2019. Only 14 submissions have been received so far this calendar year which is down on 2018 but comparable to 2017. The voluntary English language editing group which was established towards the end of 2018 has handled its first manuscript and the process was apparently quite successful. The editor, Tony Pressland, was acknowledged in the final manuscript. A couple of the Associate Editors are not performing as expected with very slow turnaround and lack of response to emails. The Editor-in-Chief and I have discussed this situation and will keep it under review.

The Special Issue from the Port Augusta conference is progressing slowly with seven papers accepted and several others nearing acceptance. The guest editors have been advised that all papers for this issue must be accepted by 30 June. Otherwise they will appear in a normal issue. The contract for the Special Issue on total grazing pressure management in the southern rangelands is currently with the legal section of NSW DPI. Paper preparation is proceeding with the expectation that all manuscripts will be submitted by 30 April although this deadline is likely to slip. It appears that the prospects for a Special Issue on drought policy and management are better than expected. Andrew Ash will maintain a liaison role with Qld DPI.

It is necessary to establish a more formal process for soliciting Special Issues which to date have been identified mainly by contacts within the Publications Committee. This process is not sustainable. Paul Novelly will convene a small working group to develop the terms of reference for a Special Issues Sub-Committee and identify potential members (not all of whom will be from the PC).

It is intended to update the flyer for The Rangeland Journal, following recent input from Advisory Editors, once the 2018 Impact Factor is available in June.

b. Range Management Newsletter

The first issue for 2019 should be posted to the web site by the time of the Council meeting. The Editor, Noelene Duckett, is beginning to implement the recommendations for future directions of RMN taken by Council at the end of 2018. The immediate focus is on broadening the range of relevant material accessible through RMN by establishing collaborative relationships with other newsletters and providing links to articles which they have produced (with appropriate acknowledgement). Reciprocal arrangements should extend the audience of RMN.

c. Web Site

ZymZen remains unresponsive and must be assumed to have collapsed. The web site is therefore currently operating on 'autopilot' which is acceptable, and invisible to the public, until either the server is shut down or some critical failure occurs.

Tenders for a rebuild of the web site on an industry-standard platform were received from three companies. Blue Platypus (BP), one of the tenderers, was commissioned to make a static copy of the site to secure the content until the new site is available. This involved only a small cost (\$220) and was undertaken independently of the tender process. In the event BP was also the preferred tenderer and the other tenderers have been notified that their bids were unsuccessful. Before confirming BP as the successful bidder, however, they were provided with a set of 38 questions based on input from site administrators, the President and conference organising committees for Canberra and Port Augusta, intended to clarify exactly what functionality would be provided for the quoted price (\$11,990 + GST for the stage 1 build) and what desired functionality would need to be provided at additional cost. The response indicates that the current functionality of the ZymZen site will be essentially duplicated but that contemplated upgrades to the existing site (e.g. improving searchability of RMN and conference archives, upgrading of conference pages) would involve additional cost. This is no different to the situation we would have faced with ZymZen. Based on this response

I have recommended that the President sign the authorisation to permit the stage 1 build to proceed. This authorisation would also provide for hosting and maintenance at an additional cost of \$708 (incl. GST) per annum (compared to the ZymZen cost of \$1650 p.a.). Stage 2 involves the transfer of a substantial number of archival pages onto the new platform. This will incur an additional cost estimated at approximately \$6000 + GST if Council elects to have BP do the work. However, it would be feasible for ARS to do this work in-house with guidance from BP.

d. Social Media

Sarah Moles is settling well into the Social Media Editor role and has indicated that she does not need to continue the former arrangement with Wright Social to provide a weekly post. Following a review of her performance after three months in the role, as required by her appointment offer, I have recommended to the President that her appointment for the full three years term be confirmed.

 - If seven papers have been accepted, this is sufficient to publish an SI, considering the annual 600 page limit by CSIRO Publishing.
 - Some of the Port Augusta papers are to be included in the Total Grazing Pressure SI

- Social Media – some Facebook posts are including content on the water quality issues in the Darling River that could be considered as political. If the posts are based on the recently released report "Response to the final report of the Independent Assessment of the 2018-19 Fish Deaths in the Lower Darling", this should be stated upfront. This matter is to be discussed with the Publications Committee Chair **(Cathy to action)**
