6. Reports

6.1 Membership Report (Don Burnside, Membership Director)

Membership Update – 25 March 2020

The summary

We currently have 226 members, including 37 complimentary members. Seventy-nine (79) members have paid for 2020, being 32 per cent of those who need to renew.

The detail

Forty five (45) members have already paid for 2020 only, and 8 people have paid for the next three year period (2020-2022). Together with the 26 members already on three year memberships (2018-2020 and 2019-2021), this makes a total of 79 members who are financial so far this year.

A further 110 members will need to renew for 2020 (or 2020-2022 if they elect for the three year membership), and will be sent reminder renewal notices during April. Because we have members now paid up until 31 December 2022, we have taken in additional membership fees – to the value of \$3,633 (excl. of GST).

Issues with renewals

Managing the membership system put in place by Blue Platypus has been frustrating all year. They (BP) were slow to get moving on getting renewal notices out, and several people trying to renew were unable to do so, with other people being sent either no tax invoice or an inaccurate one. Further, the steps to take if a member wishes to change their category (e.g. from hard copy to e-journal) when renewing are rather clunky.

Although the situation is slowly improving, in my view BP are not being sufficiently helpful, and I am still waiting for them to address problems experienced by three people who are trying to renew their memberships.

As noted in the Report from the Publications Committee, we will be reviewing these and other issues with Blue Platypus at the end of April.

Notes on financial Report for 1 January 2019 to 29 February 2020

Membership income – Membership income has only started to come in since early March when renewal notices were (finally) sent out. By 27 March, a further \$5,641 had been received. The membership income is also lower because several people renewed or joined late in 2019 for the 2020 year and that money is in the 2019 returns.

Because of payments for three-year memberships, there is \$3,663 'on hand' for 2021 and 2022 memberships already paid.

Journal income – Copyright income of \$1,297 was received in March and will be shown in future statements. It is anticipated that \$10,000 will be received from QDAF for the 'Drought' Special Issue being prepared before the end of the 2019-2020 financial year. It could be that payment for a Chinese Special Issue will also be received during 2020, but this may be delayed until because of Covid-19 issues.

Although payment of \$10,000 has been received from the Conference for the ARS2019 Special Issue, ACIAR will be providing a further \$10,000 to support 50 per cent of the cost of the SI, and payment of Open Access for five of the papers. Collectively, this should allow the whole SI to be published as Open Access, at no net cost to ARS.

Journal expenses – A half yearly payment of \$9,091 was paid to CSIRO Publishing in March and this will be shown in the next statement.

Council expenses – Payment of \$644 has been paid for transport of the ARS Archives from Adelaide to Longreach where they are being stored by David and Wendy Phelps (thanks!)

Travel support – Payment of \$2,000 has been made to Douglas Lawton for his Travel Grant. Payment of \$2,000 is owing to Lindsey Perry for her Travel Grant.

Term Deposits – to try and increase interest income given that only 0.25% is earned on the on-line savings, two term deposits have now been set up with the CBA. These are:

- \$100,000 at 1.5% interest, start date 29 November 2019 and maturing on 29 July 2020.
- \$50,000 at 1.3% interest, start date 23 March 2020 and maturing on 23 November 2020.

This report was only to the end of February as the monthly bank statements for March were not available as at the 1st April.

6.3 Publications Committee Report (Ron Hacker, Chair, Publications Committee)

The Publications Committee (PC) met on 18 March. The following matters are forwarded for Council's information and consideration.

1. The Rangeland Journal

The special Issue on *Management of Total Grazing Pressure in the Australia's southern rangelands* was published on-line on 24 March. This issue completed the 2019 volume which ran to a total of 586 pages. This is close to our contracted target of 600 pages without incurring excess page charges for the society. Only 5 papers are currently accepted for the first issue of 2020. Some 38 manuscripts, submitted in 2019, are currently in the pipeline plus a further 11 submitted in 2020 (6 other manuscripts submitted in 2020 have been rejected and one accepted).

Three other special issues are currently in the pipeline – drought management and policy in Australia, special issue from the 2019 conference, and ecological degradation and regeneration of grasslands (China). This means that a further special issue is required for 2021.

A virtual issue (VI) comprising 10 papers from TRJ, plus an introduction by Brian Walker and Mark Westoby, will be launched in the near future to celebrate the 30th anniversary (in 2019) of the seminal state-and-transition paper. This issue has been compiled by Andrew Ash. The journal should aim to publish one VI each year. (VIs are collections of papers from the journal on a particular theme which are made available on-line for free download for three months as a promotional measure).

Attention has recently been drawn to an article on the 'Beef Central' web site, based on a paper to be published in *The Rangeland Journal* and currently 'on-line early', in which the journal was referred to as a CSIRO publication. This matter has been clarified with the editor of the site. Following discussion within the committee CSIRO Publishing has been asked to insert the words 'Official Journal of the Australian Rangeland Society' under the journal title on the front cover, at the top of the Rangeland Journal home page, and in the banner of the flyer. This is actually a reversion to the wording that used to appear on the journal cover some years ago.

2. Range Management Newsletter

Issue 3 of 2019 has been loaded on the web site (but not yet available to members) and issue 1 of 2020 is almost ready for loading. Unfortunately the process is being hindered by difficulties with the operation of the new web site. In particular, Noelene Duckett is not able to shift the current newsletter to the archive when a new one is to be loaded. Blue Platypus has to date not proved very cooperative in resolving this issue. 2

3. Website

Although the new site is operational a number of functionality issues are causing concern, including the one noted above. In particular, the membership renewal system is not working correctly and appears, among other things, unable to cope with changes to an individual's subscription preferences (e.g. change for receiving hard copy to on-line only). Don Burnside has had on-going contact with Blue Platypus on these matters, including during the rebuilding process, but full functionality has not yet been achieved. In general the responsiveness of Blue Platypus to these matters has been poor, in contrast to their efficiency and cooperativeness during the tendering process, and much of the rebuilding process. A sub-committee of PC will meet in late April to review the performance of the site and our provider, and recommend a course of action. The Editor, Russell Grant, is putting considerable effort into familiarising himself with the new platform.

4. Social Media

In general, social media activity is continuing in a satisfactory manner under the Editorship of Sarah Moles. Her report is attached separately (Attachment 1).

As part of the review of social media, Council accepted a recommendation to make available a small budget to allow the editor to 'boost' some Facebook posts. The PC considered this matter and passed the following motion:

PC recommends to Council that a budget of \$300 be provided to enable boosting of Facebook pages over the remainder of 2020.

This recommendation is commended to the Council. Details of the way in which these funds can be accessed can be resolved between Sarah and Don Burnside.

5. General

- Vacancies on the Publications Committee

Two vacancies currently exist on the committee, following the resignations of Prof. David Eldridge and Assoc. Prof. Wal Whalley at the end of 2019. At the suggestion of the PC I have approached Dr Sarah McDonald regarding an appointment to the committee. She has responded positively and an expression of interest is included for Council's consideration as Attachment 2.

- New Chair of Publications Committee

I advised Council in early 2019 that I would not accept reappointment for a third term, from 1 July 2019. While I have been happy to act in this position since that time, pending an anticipated appointment, I wish to advise Council that it not my intention to continue in this role beyond 30 June 2020.

Attachment 1 – Social media report 30 Jan 2020 – 17 March 2020

As a rule of thumb, 3 posts are made on Facebook and Twitter each week. I also post anything PC members forward ASAP.

Twitter - I've added "Impressions" as this is part of Twitter's analytics and easily reported; and Profile Visits (ditto) which means people are seeking to know more about ARS.

Actual replies are few and far between. 'Retweet with comment' post about quality of internet service generated notable interaction - ~4 exchanges.

Facebook - Like and Love are by far the most widely used on our posts.

Instagram - I've been given some great images and posted one from the Marble Bar area 16/3/20. I will work through them (adding photographer details) and make more of an effort to post to Instagram regularly.
